





Dr. Knueppel has dedicated her career to the practice of optometric vision therapy, establishing The Vision Therapy Center in Wisconsin in 1995. She is a graduate of Southern California College of Optometry and completed the SUNY Vision Therapy Residency. She is a Fellow of the Optometric Vision Development & Rehabilitation Association (OVDRA). She lectures internationally on vision development, strabismus and amblyopia, vision and learning, neuro-optometric rehabilitation and prescribing therapeutic performance lenses.

Dr. Knueppel is Wisconsin Clinical Director, North America Regional Clinical Advisor and Global Faculty Advisor for the Special Olympics Lions Clubs International Opening Eyes Program; a Past President of the Wisconsin Optometric Association; and was Adjunct Clinical Faculty for Illinois College of Optometry for over 20 years. Dr. Knueppel has been an invited international clinician for ten Special Olympics World Games due to her expertise in functional lens prescribing.

Dr. Knueppel received the prestigious G.N. Getman Award from OVDRA (2021), the Golisano Health Leadership Award for North America (2023), the Award of Excellence from Wisconsin Special Olympics (2010), Wisconsin Optometric Association Optometrist of the Year (2006) and Young Optometrist of the Year (2002).

Dr. Tessa Sokol is a Wisconsin native who began her optical career in 1998 as an optician before becoming an optometrist. After earning her Doctorate in Optometry cum laude from the Illinois College of Optometry in 2007, she brought her extensive training and community-minded focus back to Wisconsin to establish Sokol Advanced Eyecare.
